

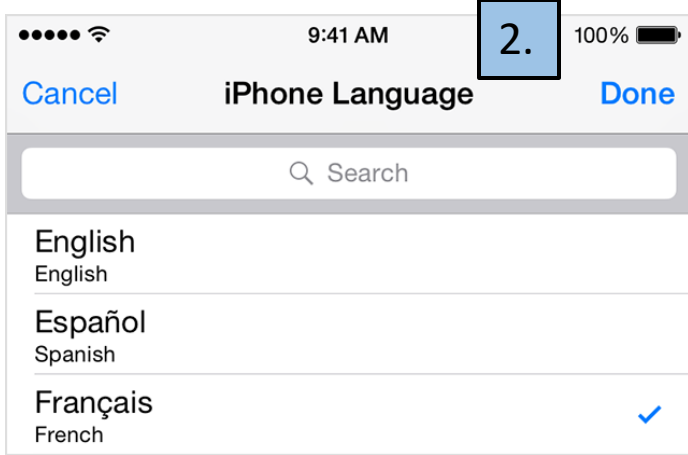
French Learning Menu

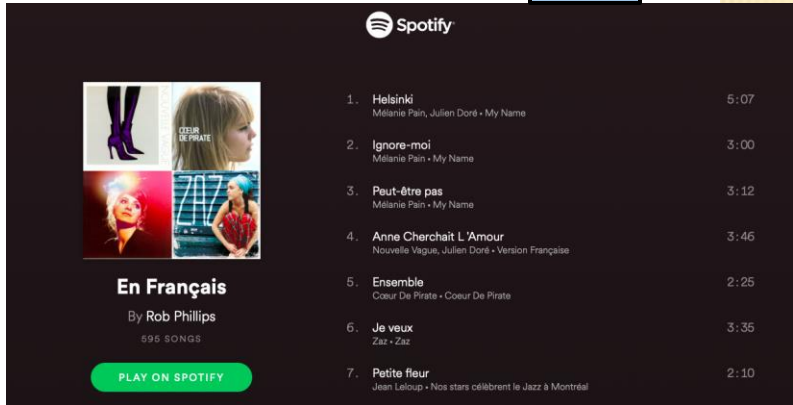
